### Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to establish that Puerto Rico Medicaid Program (PRMP) will not accept admission type codes of 6, 7, 8, or 9 on inpatient claims/encounters.

### Scope

All references to the Puerto Rico Medicaid Program (PRMP) in this policy are inclusive of Children’s Health Insurance Program (CHIP). This policy applies to providers who submit claims for reimbursement with Medicaid funds.

### Policy

The PRMP will deny inpatient claims/encounters with an admission type of 6, 7, 8, or 9. Admission type codes 6 through 8 are not yet defined for use in the national code set. Admission type code 9 is defined as information is unavailable, which should never be the case. The billing provider should always have access to the type of admission. Inpatient claims/encounters must use the most appropriate admission type code. The acceptable values are:

- 1 - Emergency
- 2 - Urgent
- 3 - Elective
- 4 - Newborn
- 5 - Trauma
